Great Impressions: Prints by Kentucky Artisans

MARCH 5 – SEPTEMBER 10, 2016

Entry applications due Jan. 9, 2016

Exhibit Description

Printmaking is one of the oldest forms of illustration and includes a wide variety of techniques and methods. This exhibit will showcase the array of printmaking styles and methods used by Kentucky artists.

For this exhibit “print” will be defined as work resulting from marks made when a plate, block, or other material/object to which wet color/ ink has been applied is pressed onto a flat surface such as paper or fabric. Works submitted can be created using relief print processes such as block prints & engravings, and intaglio processes such as etching, drypoint, and mezzotint. Screen prints, monotypes and lithographs will also to be included. Digital prints will not be considered.

Kentucky Artisan Center at Berea

The Kentucky Artisan Center at Berea is a state center that displays and sells the works of over 700 Kentucky artisans and promotes cultural heritage travel in Kentucky. The Center, located just off I-75 at Berea Exit 77 annually welcomes over 240,000 visitors.

Requirements/ Restrictions

Artists must be over 18 years of age and residents of Kentucky. Up to three entries may be submitted. Works must be created from 2011 or later, be 50 pounds or less in weight and no dimension can exceed 4 feet. Works designed to hang on the wall must be “ready to hang.” Works selected can be shipped or hand delivered to the Center. Any works that will need to be return shipped must be delivered or shipped in a sturdy, re-usable container with all packing included and a return label.

Sales

Works must be for sale and will be consigned, with the artisan receiving 60% of the retail price when the work sells. Works leave the exhibition when purchased and the Center may ask for replacements if available.

How to Enter

To enter, submit a completed entry form, an artist biography or statement and two images for each entry. Images must be of the actual works that would be on exhibit if selected.

- Images should include one overall image and one detail image per entry.
- High quality color photos or digital images will be accepted.
- Digital images must be in JPEG format, at least 300 dpi, and submitted on a CD.
- All images must be numbered to correspond with the number on the entry form.
